

Three Counties Cross Country, Wootton, 28th November 2010

Nineteen Biggleswade AC athletes ventured out on an exceptionally frosty morning on Sunday for the third round of the Three Counties Cross Country League, hosted by Wootton Roadrunners in Northampton at the historic Delapre Abbey. The ground conditions were very hard and icy in places, resulting in a few falls and injuries.

The men's team put in another strong performance to finish 5th overall, with all seven scorers in the top 50.
